After recording an EP by himself in his basement, Never Shout Never became an instant online success story, averaging over 40,000 online plays a day, and headlining shows throughout the Midwest.

The Maine formed in 2007 in Tempe, AZ, a collegiate suburb of Phoenix. Most of the band members were in high school at the time, and the guys wasted little time turning their '90s radio rock band influences into a familiar, infectious pop-punk sound. The Maine signed to Fearless Records and released a five-song concept EP, *The Way We Talk*, in 2007.
