In today's instantly downloadable and quickly consumed culture, bands like Anberlin are a dying breed. Over the course of six years and four full-lengths, the band have established themselves as one of alternative rock's most exciting acts and as a band who refuse to limit themselves to one specific scene or sound.

If the band reinvented themselves with last year's sprawling album "Cities" which debuted in the Billboard Top 20 and sold 34,000 copies its first week of release, they've transcended that sound with "New Surrender". In fact, their latest album shows the band reconciling all of their seemingly disparate moods into a cohesive blend of music that will lull you to sleep with gentle harmonies one minute and shake you to the core via raw, distortion-drenched rock riffage the next.

4TROOPS is made up of vets of the Afghanistan and Iraq Wars: Meredith Melcher, Ron Henry, David Clemo, and Daniel Jens. Their self-titled debut album, which was just released, includes a mix of patriotic and uplifting pop and country songs. The quartet, who shares a passion for singing, took part in various Army music programs such as "Military Idol" and the "Army Soldiers Show." Not only does 4TROOPS rock out in honor of its fellow service men and women, it sheds light on the needs of veterans and their families.

Group member Daniel Jens says the 11 tracks cover many musical genres. "There's one original song on there, but most of them are different covers of different genres, from Country to pop to rock, inspirational and patriotic," he said. "It's really an album for everyone." A portion of the proceeds from 4Troops' album will benefit the USO, American Legion, the Intrepid Fallen Heroes Fund, and Iraq Afghanistan Veterans of America.

Hailed as a remarkably visceral live act since their 2004 foundation, Circa Survive followed 2007's acclaimed second album, *On Letting Go*, with nearly two years of non-stop touring, roadwork which saw the band bridging a diverse range of audiences with its idiosyncratic sonic vision. In addition to treks alongside bands such as Coheed & Cambria, Thrice, Pelican, and My Chemical Romance, Circa Survive dropped jaws at such dissimilar music festivals as Vans Warped Tour and Coachella.

Their latest release "Blue Sky Noise" was polished and refined by the band from every angle. "We really wanted to make sure we were writing a cohesive full-length album," says guitarist Brendan Ekstrom. "We wanted people to listen to our record from front to back, with all the songs flowing together seamlessly. A lot of it is a reflection of our personalities and what we went through, but also a reflection of the state of music and our reaction to the disintegration of the album."
